

# Lenders

In the MRE, lenders are referenced in two places:

1. Requesting which lenders should be used in calculation of results
2. Assigning a lender to an existing loan or liability within the customer's financial data

---

## Supported lenders for calculation

When requesting calculation via the [API](#), the MRE currently supports the following list of New Zealand lenders within the `Lenders` parameter of the request payload:
